NOTICE OF SUPPLEMENTAL LEVY ELECTIONS

Notice is hereby given that pursuant to resolution of the following school districts, the following elections will be conducted for the purpose of voting upon the question for each district as follows:

Whitepine Joint School District No. 288 levy by resolution adopted February 11, 2019, for a levy in the amount of Eight Hundred Eighty Thousand dollars (\$880,000.00) per year for one (1) year for the purpose of paying all lawful expenses of maintaining and operating the schools of the district for one (1) fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019 and ending June 30, 2020.

Nezperce Joint School District No. 302 levy by resolution adopted March 11, 2019, for a levy in the amount of Four Hundred Forty-Five Thousand dollars (\$445,000.00) per year for one (1) year for the purpose of paying all lawful expenses of maintaining and operating the schools of the district for one (1) fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019.

The last day for an application for a mail-in absentee ballot to be received by the County Clerk is not later than 5:00 pm on May 10, 2019. In person absentee voting for this election is available through May 17, 2019, by 5:00 pm, at the Clearwater County Courthouse, 150 Michigan Ave, Orofino, Idaho. The last day to return absentee ballots to the County Clerk is May 21, 2019, by 8:00 pm. If you are in a Vote by Mail Precinct and you are not currently registered to vote, your Election Day registration and voting location is the Clearwater County Courthouse. Notice is further given that in accordance with the Help America Vote Act of 2002, each of the polling places is accessible to individuals with disabilities.
